ANZAC DAY MARCH:

It was a privilege to take part in the Cohuna ANZAC Day march last Thursday. On Tuesday our Grade 6 students took part in the GRIP leadership conference at Red Energy Arena in Bendigo. Throughout the day students took part in presentations, interactive activities, discussions and games designed to develop their leadership skills. The themes covered included the sacrifices leaders make, sharing new ideas and that everyone can step forward and be a leader. HATS AWAY:

Wednesday was the 1st of May which means students are no longer required to wear hats in the yard.

CROSS COUNTRY:

As with previous years students will run in their age groups (the age the child turns this year). We start with the 8 year olds, so the younger students can see where they are to run. The 5&6 year olds follow, then the 7 year olds, 9 year olds, 10 year olds and lastly the 11&12 year olds.

Children are permitted to wear a t-shirt in their house colours but are asked not to wear football jumpers or singlets as their running top. Children should also make sure they have warm clothing (in case of inclement weather). Appropriate footwear is also essential, spikes are not to be worn at this level of the competition.

Lunch will be held earlier at 12:00 pm & lunch orders will still be available on this day. Children will need plenty of water for the event and will take their school bags with them to the oval. All asthma sufferers will be required to take their asthma medication to the event with them and to carry it whilst competing.

Our cross country will be held at the Cohuna recreation reserve tomorrow Friday 3rd of May. Parent spectators are most welcome. Please do not park on the fence and take care when driving into the oval as the children will be running around the outside of the oval.

The children will travel by bus to and from the Cohuna football oval. Buses will begin leaving at 12:30 pm. the first event will be run at 12:45 pm. **Children may go home with their parents from the cross country. Parents must sign their children off on the class lists and bus rolls at the oval.**

Cross Country permission forms are due back tomorrow, Friday, 3rd May at the latest.

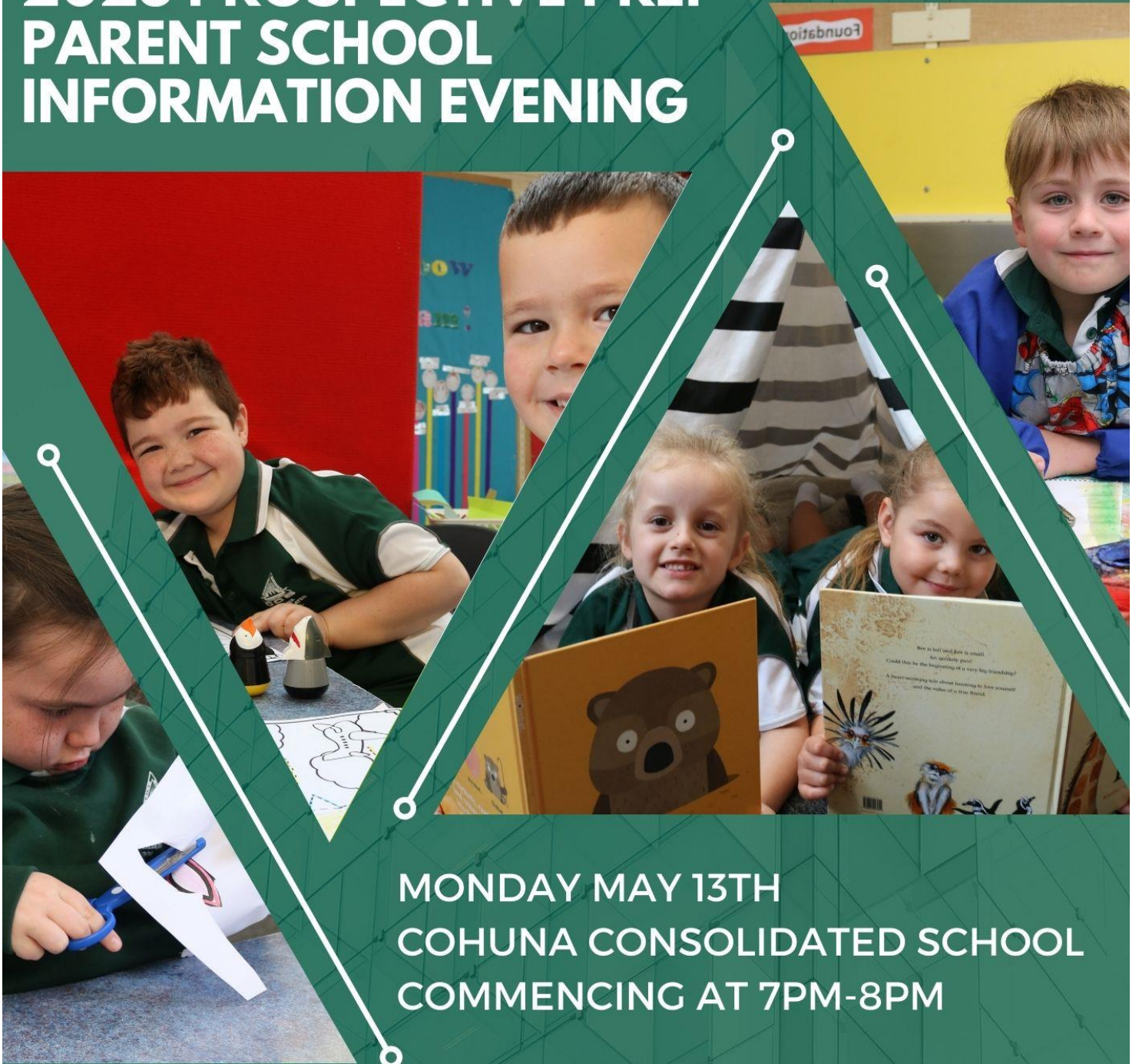
